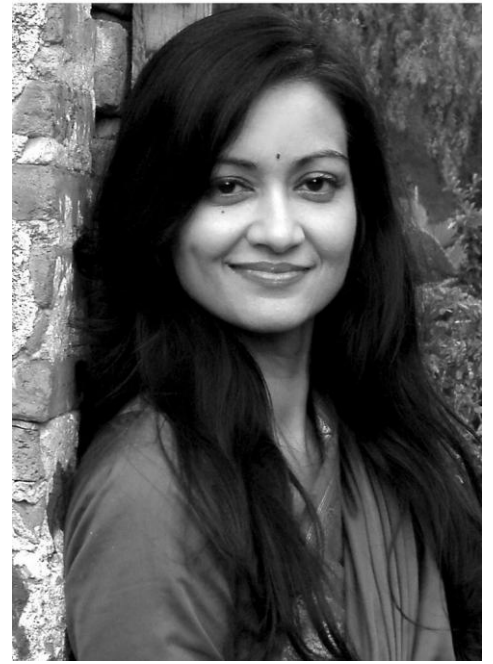


Tripura Rahasya

Parvathi was born in Bihar, India, within a family from an ancient lineage of Yoga and Vedanta. She was educated according to these teachings and principles and 8 year-old began his training with a yogini adept. It was formally launched at the Marga of Shaivism Pratyabhijana Kashmiriano. Throughout the years, she received the complete transmission of this tradition, integrating the Samaya Tantra Yoga and Vedanta (specific scientific school of wisdom yogi). Parvathi is the disciple of Lalita Devi and heir to the deepest tantric tradition of Shaivism Kashmiriano. Nath's lineage goes to Matsyendranath it and through it, to the oldest sources of Shaivism. Is this teacher Abhinavagupta emblematic honors him at the opening of its Tantrāloka, Kaula lineage as the initiator of. Later, she received transmissions Shree Vidya through eminent Shree Saraswati Devipuram Amritananda.
